WHAT FLOWER TO GIVE ON MOTHER'S DAY?

card with buttons

YOU WILL NEED

- cardboard in different colours
- pencil crayons • buttons
- glue • scissors • stickers
- khokis • ruler • paint

WHAT TO DO

- 1 Fold a sheet of A4 cardboard in half.
- 2 Cut a square from another colour cardboard. It must be smaller than your card. Glue it onto the centre of the card.
- 3 Now you can decorate your card. Draw and cut out flower petals from the leftover cardboard. Glue them onto the card.
- 4 Glue a button into the middle of the petals.
- 5 Use the khokis or paint to draw stems.

Egg-carton flowers

YOU WILL NEED

- paint
- cardboard egg carton
- plastic straws or wooden kebab sticks
- scissors
- decorations like glitter, plastic bottle lids, pompoms, wax crayons
- glue
- sticky tape
- paintbrush

WHAT TO DO

- 1 Cut flower shapes out of the egg carton. Trim around the edges to give them a rounder shape for the petals of the flower.
- 2 Paint the flowers and let dry.
- 3 Decorate the flowers. We used crayons, glitter, plastic bottle lids and pompoms.
- 4 Glue or sticky tape the straw to the back of the flower.

TIP

BATH BOMBS

YOU WILL NEED

- red or pink food colouring • 1 lemon
- ½ cup salt • ¾ cup cornflour
- 1 cup bicarbonate of soda • 1 tablespoon oil
- 1 teaspoon water • silicone moulds

WHAT TO DO

Mix all the dry ingredients together in a bowl. In a separate bowl, mix the wet ingredients together. Add the wet ingredients to the dry ingredients. Mix well. Place the mixture into silicone moulds and let dry overnight.

Jewellery stand

A special place for Mom's rings and earrings.

YOU WILL NEED

- 11 large ice-cream sticks
- paint in a variety of colours
- paintbrush
- 2 large empty matchboxes
- craft glue
- 2 short pins
- Prestik

WHAT TO DO

- 1 Paint the ice-cream sticks and matchboxes in any colours you like. Let them dry.
- 2 Glue the matchboxes side by side to make the drawers. Press in the pins to make the handles. Use a piece of Prestik to close the sharp end of the pin.
- 3 Take three ice-cream sticks and form a triangle. Glue the three



ends together. Repeat this step so that you have two triangles.

- 4 Once the glue has dried, place the matchboxes in between the two triangles and secure them with glue. Let the glue dry.
- 5 Take the rest of the sticks and glue them horizontally between the triangles – leaving a 2cm space between each stick.
